

How to Get Colombia Mercosur Visa?

The Colombia Mercosur visa is intended for citizens of countries who are either permanent or associate members of Mercosur economic bloc. The associate members are Colombia, Peru, Ecuador, Chile, and Bolivia.



Passport Photocopy

A photocopy of the first page of your valid passport showing your biographical data.



Proof of Legal Entry

A photo or scan of the page from your passport showing last stamp of entry or departure from Colombia.



Previously Issued Visa

Photo/Scan of your most recent visa from Colombia if you have one.



Passport photo:

Digital visa photo, white background, 100 Kb max size, jpg file. No ear rings, no hats, no white shirts.



Certified Criminal History Report:

Certificate of judicial or criminal record of your country of origin or of the place where you resided during the 3 years prior to the application with an issue date not exceeding three (3) months at the time of registration. The document must be apostilled, legalized or certified by the Consulate of the country accredited in Colombia. If the report is in a language other than Spanish, it must be translated and legalized.

NEW residents must have travelers health insurance for duration of visa. **Existing residents must have Colombian Health Insurance**
