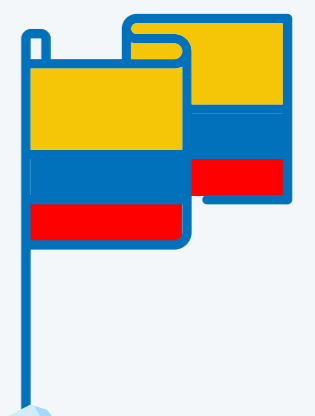




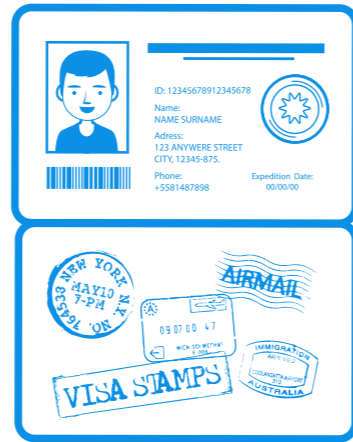
Documents required for Colombian Marriage Visa



Marriage Certificate:

A

Notarized copy of marriage certificate. Must be issued within 90 days prior to the visa application.



Passport Copy

B

A copy of the first page of your valid passport showing your biographical data.



Proof of Legal Entry

C

A photo or scan of the page from your passport showing last stamp of entry or departure from Colombia.



Previously Issued Visa

D

Photo/Scan of your most recent visa from Colombia if you have one.



Letter from spouse

E

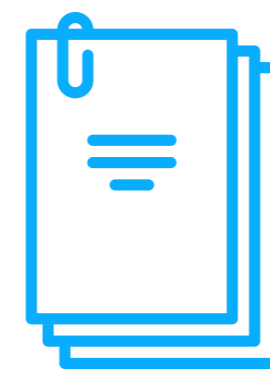
Notarized authorization letter from the Colombian spouse granting you legal power to apply for the visa.



Cédula Copy

F

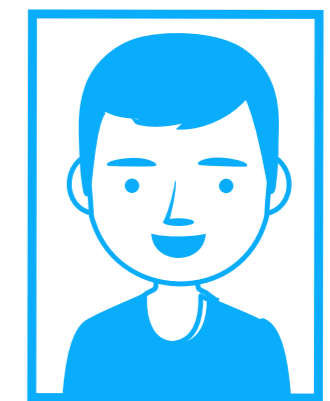
Notarized copy of the cedula of the Colombian spouse or permanent partner.

Migracion Colombia certificate of your last 5 years of entries & exits



Passport photo:

H

Digital visa photo, white background, 100 Kb max size, jpg file. No ear rings, no hats, no white shirts.



NEW residents must have travelers health insurance for duration of visa. Existing residents must have Colombian Health Insurance



IMPORTANT: Additional documents may be requested by Visa Officials. Visa Processes Change Frequently. **ALL MIGRANT VISAS** - If you stay out of Colombia more than 180 days in a single trip, your visa will be cancelled. The marriage visa has full work privileges, but your employer must register you with migracion, and work ministry.
