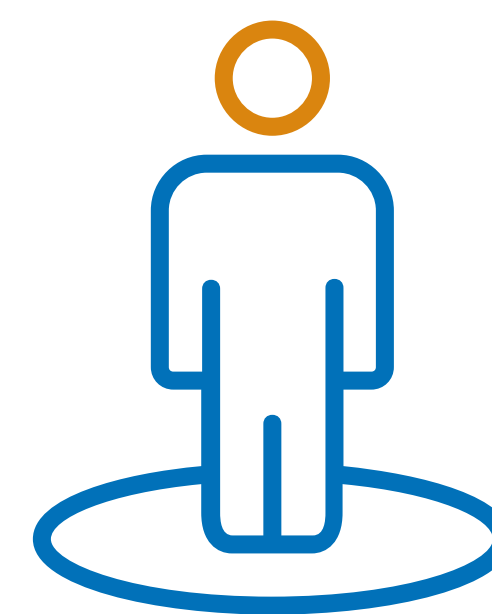

What is an Apostille?

What is an Apostille?

An apostille is a certificate that certifies a notary or government signature is valid. This second certification handled by the government allows the document to be accepted internationally under the Hague Convention of 1961.

Who Issues an Apostille?

Usually, an apostille is issued by a Secretary of State's office, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Notary commissioning agency, or a similar designated authority from the country where the document originates. In the United States it is the Secretary of State.

Which Countries are Part of the Hague convention?

There are a total of 98 nations that are part of the Apostille Convention. Many countries such as Canada, China, Cuba, are not part of the Hague convention. These countries have extra steps in the legalization processes similar to the Apostille.
